Studies in Journalism and Media Studies prepare students for careers in mass media, including broadcast news, multimedia journalism, advertising, public relations and photojournalism. The curriculum emphasizes the skills of gathering, evaluating, writing, and disseminating information and related skills. Students are also instructed in the theory, law, history, and professional guidelines of mass media.
